NEW EXEMPT WELL REGISTRATION APPLICATION

To qualify as a New Exempt Well under the Rules of the District the well to be drilled Must:

- (1) meet the tract size and spacing requirements found in Appendix A of the District Rules and:
 - (A) be equipped so that it is incapable of producing more than 25,000 gallons per 24 hour period.
 - (B) be drilled on a tract smaller than 10 acres in size with a casing diameter not larger than 5 inch inside diameter which complies with (A) above.
- (2) drilled on a tract of any size which was platted prior to September 1, 2009 and not subsequently divided into smaller tracts with a casing diameter of not more than 5 inch inside diameter and incapable of producing more than 25,000 gallons per 24 hour period.
- (3) drilled or operated as leachate wells and monitoring wells.

If the proposed well will not comply with provisions listed above the well owner should contact the District.

APPLICATION TO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY THE "WELL OWNER". "WELL OWNER" means the person who owns a possessory interest in: (1) the land upon which a well or well system is located or to be located; (2) the well or well system; or (3) the groundwater withdrawn from a well or well system. (A potential purchaser of the land, well/ system or groundwater is not the Well Owner)
