Notice is hereby given that the following applications for existing wells have been determined to be administratively complete. The Permit Applications and this Notice are in accordance with District Rule 3.52 Existing Non-exempt Wells Used for Domestic, Livestock or Poultry Purposes.

**Location Of Well(s):** 2701 Hwy. 281 North, Burnet, Texas

The well(s) are equipped to produce in excess of 25,000 gallons of water in a 24 hour period (17.365 gallons per minute). The use of the water is for domestic (which includes irrigation of family lawns, or of a family garden and/or orchard), livestock, or poultry. The wells meet the requirements for Operating Permits issued pursuant to § 3.52 and other applicable Rules of the District. They are issued with provisions that limit production generally to only the amount of water that can be used beneficially for the specified purpose of use, instead of limiting production authorization to an express annual production volume.

**Action by General Manager**

It is the intent of the General Manager to approve the Permit Application on Friday, April 12, 2013.

**Protest Application**

On or before April 11, 2013 an affected person may formally protest the application by submitting a contested case hearing request using the procedures provided for in Section 7.60 of the District Rules.
